Housing Information & Rules 2016

Prior to arriving at Rendezvous, please fill out your bunk cards. Please divide your crew into the following categories.

Number of Male Youth
Number of Female Youth
Number of Male Adults
Number of Female Adults

Bunk cards are to be attached by masking tape on the bunk frame facing central walk way.

If arriving Thursday night please call or text **Daniel at 714-473-8153**, you will be assigned bunks upon arrival. Daniel will be assisted by Vanya Keys.

Friday morning, Daniel will be at registration assigning bunks to the Boatswain Mate. The Boatswain Mate then directs crew to bunks while the Boatswain finishes registration.

Barracks are non-heated concrete buildings in November. Only mattresses are provided. Bring your own sheets, winter sleeping bag, and pillow. Each barracks has a shared central head with toilets and open showers.

Your quarters will be inspected during competition hours Friday and Saturday. This is a required event. Please see the Rendezvous Manual for what we look for.

No eating in the barracks. Eat outside, and throw away your trash.

There is no reason for anyone to be outside of the barracks between lights out and reveille. Being found outside could be grounds for conduct point deduction to going home in the morning, depending on the situation.

Any maintenance issues must be reported to Daniel Stoica (714-473-8153) immediately.

Final Cleaning Before Check Out 2016

Cleaning supplies will be issued at end of weekend. Everyone will be responsible for cleaning around their bunks, and helping clean the shared heads. Let's leave this place clean so we can come back next year. They will be inspected as part of final check out.

Bunks

All trash and litter out.
Sweep around your bunks.

Heads

All trash and litter out.
Wipe out sinks. Clean mirrors if needed.
Toilets & urinals clean.
Mop head floor and showers.
